

Sparkling Wine

Prosecco, Pirani D.O.C Extra Dry, Italy (Veneto)

A beautiful straw yellow with elegant perlage. Soft notes of apple. Very easy drinking.

Highweald Brut Reserve NV, England (Sussex)

Light straw in colour with a fine persistent mousse. Our signature wine is elegant with aromas of orchard and citrus fruit, toast and spice.

Highweald Rose NV, England (Sussex)

Beautiful, vibrant rose-pink with a fine persistent mousse. Intense and seductive aroma of English summer berries with a delicate toasted cedar-spice note.

Rathfinny Classic Cuvee 2018, England (Sussex)

Vivid aromas of grapefruit, red apple and brioche on the nose. The palate has a real focus with zesty acidity tempered by a creamy texture and rich biscuity notes, leading to a refreshing moreish finish.

Dessert Wines

Chateau Les Mingets Sauternes, France (Sauternes)

A concentrated, luscious dessert wine showing intense flavours of caramelized fruits, pear, melon and almond, rounded and balanced by good acidity.

V Vegan Wine

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White Wine

▼ Grillo, Petrarinusa Organic, Italy (Sicily)

Distinct and characterful aromas of citrus fruit underlaid by juicy and refreshing tropical notes with mouth-filling lychee and pineapple flavours.

▼ Sea Change Pinot Grigio, Italy (Veneto)

Balanced, fresh and crisp, with aromas of freshly cut pears, kiwifruit and musk, with hints of citrus flowers and nougat. Fruity and floral flavours flow across the palate, and a lovely juicy acid line trails through the wine.

Writers Block Chenin Blanc, S.Africa (W.Cape)

This lovingly crafted Chenin Blanc delivers a medley of ripe fruits of pear, peach and honeydew melon with a zesty citrus finish.

▼ Janelas Antigas, Vinho Verde, Portugal (Vinho Verde)

An exciting and refreshing wine that perfectly combines the aromas of four of the most famous grape varieties of the region resulting in a very fresh and fruity wine, with a balanced acidity. Its great for pairing with salads, fish and seafood dishes or can be served on its own.

▼ Pecorino, Bio Dega Vigna Madre Organic, Italy (Abruzzo)

Floral notes of broom and hawthorn, and then continues with scents of lemon zest, pear and apple, then it ends with scents of freshly cut grass. Fresh and savoury with a slight buttery note.

Picpoul de Pinet Villa Blanche, France (Languedoc)

Brilliant yellow with green reflections. Nose of acacia flowers and broom with citrus notes emerging before finishing on mint, star anise and marine, iodized notes. Very fresh and smooth in the mouth, opening on exotic fruit and finishing with a lightly lemony, mineral, salinity.

Sauvignon Blanc, Akarana, New Zealand (Waipara)

Vibrant and bursting with zesty citrus fruit flavours.

Corte del Duca Gavi di Gavi, Italy, (Piedmont)

Distinguished by its delicate aroma reminiscent of fresh fruit, it is pale yellow in colour with greenish hues, and dry flavour with underlying good acidity.

Highweald Ghyll Valley White England (Sussex)

Attractive nose of greengage and white peach, with highlights of elderflower and blossom. Bright, smooth and refreshing.

Rose Wine

▼ Entreflores Rose, Spain (Navarra)

Intensely fresh to the nose, with noticeable aromas of strawberry and flowers. Well balanced and tasty in the mouth.

▼ Sea Change Pinot Grigio Rosé, Italy (Veneto)

The nose is packed with notes of wild strawberry, cranberry and a hint of juniper. Fresh and crispy, light and easy to drink.

Marius Peyol Rose, France (Provence)

This delicately pale pink wine has flavours of red fruit, blossom and gentle spice notes

▼ Mirada Organic Rose, Spain (Castilla)

Pale pink with aromas of wild strawberry, white peach and citrus. The palate is dry, fresh and well rounded with a cleansing mineral finish. (Gold Medal Concours Mondial de Bruxelles 2023-24)

Red Wine

▼ Nero D'Avola, Petrarinusa Organic, Italy (Sicily)

A characterful fruit-driven red, which is soft, approachable and easy to drink. Intense and well-balanced, packed with red berry fruit flavours.

▼ Merlot, Daguet de Berticot, France (Cotes de Duras)

The wine has a ruby red colour. The nose reveals notes of red fruits and spice. The palate is full of smooth tannins.

▼ Recantos de Lisboa Reserva Tinto, Portugal (Lisbon)

This Reserva red wine has a wonderful nose, harmoniously blended on the palate. Intense red fruits are accompanied by delicate spice aromas. It is soft full-bodied, with a persistent finish.

▼ Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Bio Dega Vigna Madre Organic, Italy (Abruzzo)

Ruby red in colour, there are red fruits such as cherry, blueberry, blackcurrant and plum on the nose as well as some floral notes of rose and violet. On the palate it is dry and refreshing with soft tannins. The red fruits are expressed in all its glory.

Piquepoul Noir Villa Blanche, France (Languedoc)

Fresh with red cherry in all its forms, and floral notes such as broom flowers followed by spicy notes of peppermint and star anise. Fine tannins, delicious pomegranate and redcurrant. This is a wine that we prefer served simply, lightly chilled.

▼ Malbec, Bodega Piedra Negra Organic, Argentina (Mendoza)

On the nose red summer fruit aromas dominate with a slight touch of black pepper. On the palate there is an attractive concentration of ripe red fruits which gives volume to the wine.

Domaine P Sichel Altura 350 Biodynamic, France (Languedoc)

Packed full of flavours of red cherry and aromas of wild herbs and spicy black pepper, this red is produced from a small estate high in the Corbieres mountains.

Orange & Natural

▼ Logan Clementine Pinot Gris Natural, Australia (NSW)

Lovely sunset orange in colour. It has bright and rich aromas of red apple, wild strawberry, florals (honeysuckle and rose) and spice (cinnamon, ginger & fennel seed) with stone fruit.

▼ Logan Clementine Blanc de la Mer, Australia (NSW)

Bright aroma of grapefruit, passionfruit, rose, poached quince and nashi pear with white peach, salty tang of sea spray on the palate.
